## 66m/- water project completed in Moshi

A water supply project worth Euros 31,000 equivalent to Tshs 66 million has been completed and handed over to Msareni Primary School in Uru North Ward, Moshi district.

The project was officially inaugurated and handed over on Tuesday 6th December 2011 and will benefit Msareni Primary School and nearby residents of Njari Village located in Uru North Ward.

It is financed by the German government through its Ministry of Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) and channeled through an International non-governmental organization based in Germany known as People Health People (PHP) while being coordinated by a local non-governmental organization known as Friends in Development Association (FIDA).

Inaugurating and handing over this project to the respective school, were the representative of PHP, Hartmut Ring and the Chairman of FIDA,

Samwel who together symbolized this occasion by turning out a cloth covering a statute containing the names of people and organizations which participated in realizing this water supply project.

Receiving the project on behalf of his school Head teacher of Msareni School, Casmir Tarimo thanked the German government, FIDA and PHP for their assistance and tireless efforts which have made the dream of having clean and safe water at his school a reality.
